

**GOVERNMENT OF UTTAR PRADESH

TENDER DOCUMENT FOR ISSUANCE OF
HIGH SECURITY REGISTRATION PLATES**

TENDER NOTICE

High Security Registration Plate has been introduced by the Government of India as the highly sensitive product for prevention of counterfeiting and duplication of Registration Plate and the Government of Uttar Pradesh intends to implement the aforesaid scheme as prescribed in Rule 50 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and Motor Vehicles (New High Security Registration Plates) Order, 2001 as amended from time to time issued in this respect by the Government of India and to ensure uniformity in size, colour and specification of the High Security Registration Plate for all type of vehicles being registered / already registered as per provisions of the Rules. It is, therefore, intended to select an eligible Bidder having type approval certificate from agencies authorized in this behalf by the Government of India.

The Transport Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh, on behalf of the Government of Uttar Pradesh invites Bids for selecting Bidder to create infrastructure for supplying and affixing of High Security Registration Plate in entire State of Uttar Pradesh in conformity with the said Rules and Order.

The Bidder implementing the project will establish necessary infrastructure for the issuance and affixing of High Security Registration Plates, maintain and operate the infrastructure, formalities, services and establishment so created, at his own risk and costs including Site implementation and Networking within the State of Uttar Pradesh.

Tender Documents may be purchased from the Office of the Transport Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh, Tehri Kothi, Lucknow from 10.11.2015 to 04.01.2016 both days inclusive, between 9.30 hrs. to 16.00 hrs, against non-refundable fee of Rs. 50,000/- in cash or by Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque issued by any Scheduled Bank payable at Lucknow in favour of Transport Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh. Alternatively, the tender documents can be downloaded from the web site of the Transport Department (www.uptransport.org) or U.P. Government website (www.upgov.nic.in) in which case a demand draft of Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) only will have to be enclosed towards the cost of Tender Documents at the time of submission of Bid.

Bid must be accompanied with the EMD of Rs 2,50,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Fifty Lakhs Only) in form of Bank Draft / Banker's Cheque issued by a Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of Transport Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh payable at Lucknow, or in the form of Bank Guarantee of the same amount issued by a Nationalized Bank and valid for a period of 6 months. No Exemption Certificate will be accepted.

Tender duly filled and signed shall be submitted on 04.01.2016 between 9.30 AM to 4.00 PM.

NOTE: In petition(s) for Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No 11652 / 2012 (From judgment and Order dated 3-4-2012 in WP No 7447 / 2011 of the Hon'ble High Court of UP at Lucknow) M/S Shimnit Utsch India P. Ltd vs Celex Technologies P. Ltd and others, Hon'ble Supreme Court has passed following order on dated 12-4-2012:

1. *“Although yesterday we had issued notice on the Special Leave Petition, we had kept the matter today for considering the issuance of interim orders on the petition.*
2. *Having heard learned counsel for the respective parties, and considering the balance of convenience and inconvenience as also the general public interest, we direct that the operation of the impugned judgment and the order of the High Court shall remain stayed, except to the extent that the respondent-State will be at liberty to proceed with the tender process and may even finalise the same, but no contract is to be awarded pursuant thereto, without the leave of this Court. The stay granted will not entitle the petitioner to operate the contract in the meantime.*
3. *The respondents will be entitled to file their respective counter affidavits to the Special Leave Petition within two weeks; rejoinder, thereto, if any, may be filed within a week thereafter.*
4. *List this matter immediately after three weeks (3rd May, 2012), fairly at the top, having regard to the directions given by this Court in Maninderjit Singh Bitta's case.”*

It is, therefore, made clear that this tender process is subject to above order of Hon'ble Supreme Court
