Please refer to this office letter No. No.DC/OPS/TPT/2016//Pt./3599-3633 dated 21.09.2016 vide which it was informed that the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the matter of Vardhaman Kaushik Vs. Union of India & Ors. has issued directions, as a last opportunity vide order dated 20.07.2016 that every State / UT has to identify areas where the dispersion of the air is higher and vehicular density is least and put the same on their respective websites so that RTO Delhi can issue NOC for transfer of de-registered vehicles only for such identified areas (Copy enclosed for ready reference).

2. You were requested to identify areas where the dispersion of the air is higher and vehicular density is least and to put the data of such areas on the website of the Transport Department of your State / UT as per directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal at the earliest. It was also requested that a copy of such list may be sent to this department also, so as to issue NOCs for that areas only.

3. It is to say that no communication in this regard has been received from your State / UT because of which the NOCs for transfer of vehicles to other States are held up.

4. It is, therefore, again requested the exercise for identification of such areas suitable for issuance of NOCs, in accordance with the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, may please be completed at the earliest and be sent to this department for further necessary action.

Sub: De-registration of 15 years old Diesel Vehicles in Delhi

Sir,

This is to inform that the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the matter of Vardhaman Kaushik Vs. Union of India & Ors. has issued directions, as a last opportunity vide order dated 20.07.2016 that every State / UT has to identify areas where the dispersion of the air is higher and vehicular density is least and put the same on their respective websites so that RTO Delhi can issue NOC for transfer of de-registered vehicles only for such identified areas.

2. The operative part of the order is as under:-

"...We make it clear that deregistration of the diesel vehicles, more than 10 years old shall be complied with effectively and without default. However, the deregistration authorities are directed to start deregistration with reference to the oldest of the vehicles. In other words at the first step the vehicles which are more than 15 years old would be deregistered and then gradually other vehicles would be deregistered from 15 years to 10 years respectively.

2. All the vehicles which are deregistered in Delhi/NCR would not be permitted to ply in Delhi/NCR. However, the authorities will issue NOC for such vehicles to be registered outside the Delhi/NCR. We further clarify that in terms of the orders of the Tribunal every State has to identify areas where the dispersion of the air is higher and vehicular density is least. if the States have not done it so far we grant last opportunity to the States and the Union Territories to identify such areas and put them on the respective websites. The RTO, Delhi will issue NOC for transfer of these vehicles only for such areas which are identified by the States..."

3. You are, therefore, requested to identify areas where the dispersion of the air is higher and vehicular density is least and to put the data of such areas on the website of the Transport Department of your State / UT as per directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal at the earliest. A copy of such list may be sent to this department also, so as to issue NOCs for that areas only.

4. In accordance with the direction of Hon'ble NGT, the RTOs in Delhi will issue the NOC for transfer of these vehicles only after identification of such areas by your State/UTs. The exercise, therefore, needs to be completed on priority to enable the RTOs in processing the NOC cases for transfer of vehicles.
